

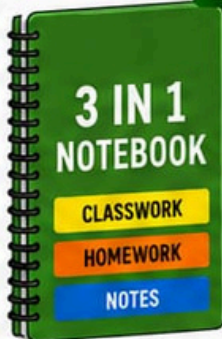

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Write all subjects in 3 in 1 notebook.
- The notebook should be properly covered and labelled with:
 - Student's Name
 - Class & Section
 - Roll Number
 - Session
 - "SUMMER VACATION HOMEWORK"(on the front cover)

- Use separators or coloured pages for each subject.
- Index should be prepared at the beginning of the notebook.
- The date must be written for every activity.
- Handwriting should be neat and readable.
- Use only pencil for written work.
- Diagrams and drawings should be properly coloured and labelled.
- Avoid overwriting and untidy presentations.

HOMEWORK COMPLETION GUIDELINES



- Complete homework regularly instead of doing it at the last moment.
- Work independently.
- Seek parental guidance but do not complete the work on their behalf.
- Every task should reflect creativity, understanding, and effort.
- Read instructions carefully before starting the work.

- Learn a hobby or skill for personal growth.





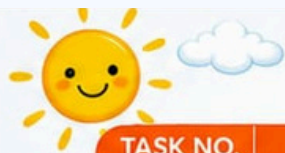
